Call for Papers, SEA

The 90th Annual Meeting of the Southern Economic Association® will be held in New Orleans, LA at the New Orleans Marriott, November 21-23, 2020 (Saturday to Monday).

In response to widespread disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in the United States and abroad, the SEA has extended the deadline paper submissions and complete session proposals to Monday, April 20, 2020.

Abstract and paper submissions should be submitted online at the SEA 2020 Conference page (<https://www.southerneconomic.org/conference/>) beginning January 2020. Participants unable to submit online may contact the SEA Office at sea@ttu.edu for assistance. The SEA charges a \$35 submission fee for all conference submissions. Only one submission fee is necessary for each single abstract submitted (even if there are multiple authors). All submissions and fees should be received no later than **April 20, 2020**.

Submission fees may be paid via credit card or check and are **nonrefundable**. - Coauthor(s) Name, Affiliation, Email Address, and Telephone Number
- Title of paper
- Paper Abstract

SEA policy waives SUBMISSION FEES for papers submitted as part of a COMPLETE session proposal. The President-Elect and Program Chair, Julie L. Hotchkiss, will review complete session proposals for consideration of inclusion on the 2020 conference program. Individually submitted abstracts will be reviewed by a Program Planning Board composed of members of the SEA Board of Trustees. Acceptance notifications will be emailed by mid-June.
